The Challenge

August 2005: the European Parliament introduces the new WEEE directive (Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment). EU member states must translate this directive into national legislation, resulting in a vast number of differences between the countries. Differences in definitions, classifications, registration options and the content and frequency of reports.

Companies are required to comply with legislation which demands that reports are submitted in every EU country they put electrical and electronic equipment for the first time on the market.

These requirements apply to Cisco in a number of member states. Cisco even went one step further. It decided to take over the WEEE responsibilities for its partners selling Cisco products on the market. In order to put this goal into action, the Cisco WEEE ops team was set up. The team was assigned the task of identifying the statutory requirements for each EU member state and to register Cisco where possible. In addition, the team is responsible for submitting the required WEEE declarations.

However, as the team quickly discovered, creating reports and submitting declarations are time-consuming activities. Knowledge of WEEE legislation had to be combined with data processing skills. This combination of skills was not immediately at the disposal of the members of the team. The development of these skills would require too much time, and would also mean slowing down the progress of the WEEE ops team's core activities. The team was also under pressure to submit reports on a continual basis within specific deadlines.

The data specifically required for the declaration was not easy to combine in the ERP systems. Additional skills had to be developed for this purpose, such as specialised data analysis and processing. An expansion of the team would however lead to an increase in the fixed costs which did not fit within the Cisco strategy.

The Results - Three years later

For Cisco, a timely and accurate WEEE declaration is essential to remaining compliant. Outsourcing the preparation and submission of the WEEE declarations to Pincvision gives companies the guarantee that all of their declarations will be submitted by the specific deadline. Regardless of whether the declarations must be submitted monthly or annually, Pincvision ensures the desired level of continuity.

The Cisco team gradually transferred responsibility to Pincvision based on precise communication and mutual trust. Cisco has various sources of information from which the necessary data must be deduced.
